An international network of academic and professional partners fosters academic, personal, and relational growth.



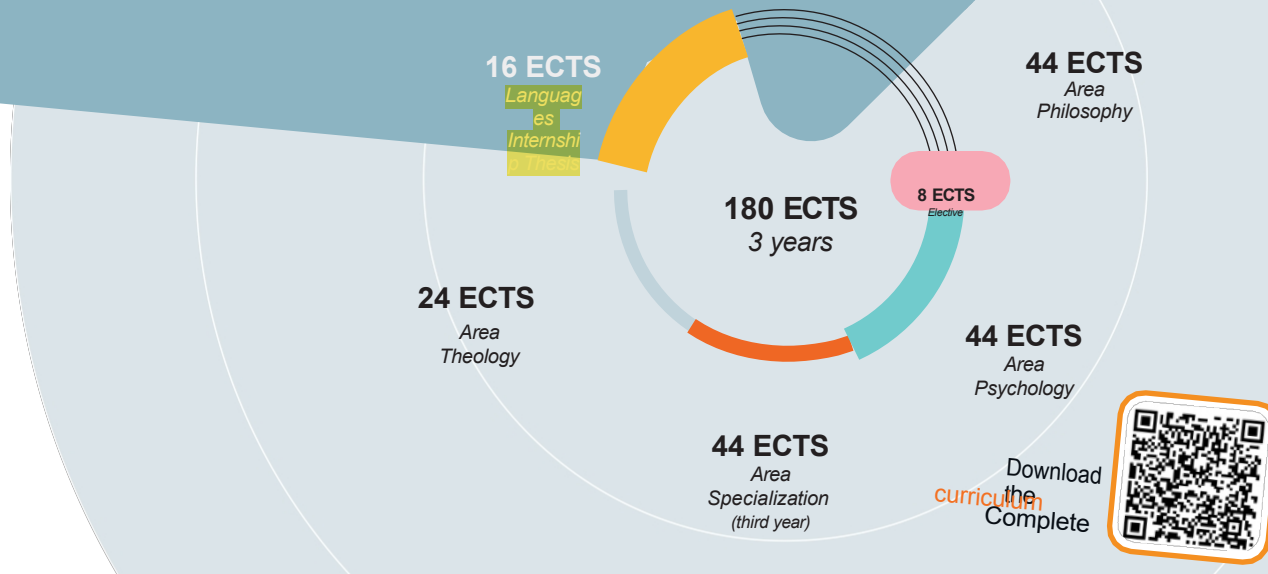
PHILOSOPHY AND HUMANITIES

Bachelor's Degree

The Bachelor's Degree in Philosophy and Human Sciences at Sophia University Institute is a degree program that offers an interdisciplinary education centered on the person, in their cognitive, relational, and social dimensions.

The program integrates philosophy, psychology, and theology, developing critical and analytical skills to interpret contemporary complexity.

Philosophy serves as the backbone and engages with other disciplines within a unified vision of knowledge. The program allows you to earn a dual academic degree—ecclesiastical and state-recognized—in collaboration with the University of Perugia.

DUAL DEGREE AWARDED

Sophia University Institute is an academic institution established by the Dicastery for Culture and Education of the Catholic Church that awards the Bachelor’s degree in Philosophy and Human Sciences.

Thanks to our partnership with the University of Perugia, students can earn a dual degree: a state-recognized academic degree in addition to an ecclesiastical one—specifically, a Bachelor’s Degree in Philosophy and Human Sciences (*Interclass L-5 / L-24 in the Italian university system*).
